### 3.1 Dates and Pricing

These are the dates and times by which the entry and payment must be **received**. The postmark of any correspondence will **not** be considered when determining whether an entry is received early. We remind competitors that instant credit card payment is available through the web site, [my.NasaRallySport.com](http://my.NasaRallySport.com).

### 3.2 Entry Procedure

The early and regular entry pricing is available only to competitors who have entered and paid in full by the deadlines above. Submitting an entry without payment is not sufficient to obtain early or regular entry prices. Entering and withdrawing are the only actions available. Entries are not transferable to another person or entity. Entry fees being refunded will not be held until next year nor are the fees transferable as a credit toward another rally.

All entry details and payment are handled within your account at [my.NasaRallySport.com](http://my.NasaRallySport.com). Also available within your account is immediate credit card payment of the entry fee. Your entry will only be secured with payment in full. Most people find the entry process to be easier on a computer rather than their phone.

Check through the entry details within your account and ensure that they are filled out for competitors, crew, and vehicles. Please note that items you input are manually verified by a person and will not immediately change status from red to green

as you enter information. Check back in a few days for status. All items must be green before race day except for social media handles.

Your account never goes away, if you have previously raced or volunteered with us please take the time to use your existing account for your entry and find your codriver's and crew chief's correct account to associate with your entry.

Note that you will also need a **NASA Membership, NASA Rally License, and an approved NASA Rally Medical**. These things are also obtained through your account on the NASA Rally Sport website. New medical forms are due no later than 5 days before event registration opens to allow time for processing and review. Most medical form problems arise from not reading the directions on the form carefully or not filling it out completely, please be attentive to details. When possible, competitors are strongly encouraged to submit medical forms a month or more in advance.

New Competitors are encouraged to enter early to ensure they are invited to Novice Competitor Orientation and can get their entry paperwork together on time. If you are delaying entry to finish a vehicle build, competitors are advised that the withdrawal cost when you are refunded close to the event is similar to the additional cost of waiting to enter in a later entry period.

Competitors will be required to sign a registration and insurance waiver, a standard liability waiver, a property damage waiver, a media authorization, a HIPPA waiver and a stage note disclaimer at the on-site rally registration.

### 3.3 Event Cancellation

The organizers reserve the right to cancel the event if insufficient entries are received before the Early Entry Deadline.

### 3.4 Number of Entrants Accepted

Initially, 50 entries will be reserved for cars and 50 entries will be reserved for motorcycles. When Regular entry begins, these reservations are removed. A total of 100 minutes worth of vehicles will be accepted.

### 3.5 Eligible Classes

Sandblast Rally will score the Atlantic Rally Cup classes: RM, AWD, 2WD and PRO.

The following car classes will be scored during the rally although they do not count toward a championship. Sandblast After Dark will only score the below list, and PRO classes:

For RallyMoto™, the following motorcycle classes will be scored for the rally and Sandblast After Dark:

\*NOTE: Novice competitors **must** receive approval from the NASA Rallysport Championship Director to enter RallyMoto Adventure Class.

### 3.6 Side by Sides

SxS vehicles that comply with section 6 of NASA Rallysport GRRs can compete.

SxS vehicles that have a license plate and insurance can enter. All others please contact the registrar for information on competing. Options are available to run some of the stages with non-road legal SxS.

### 3.8 Refunds

All refunds will be issued by check or credit card refund following the completion of the event.

- Entry fees shall be refunded in full if the event is canceled by the organizer.
- Entry fees shall be refunded in full if the organizer refuses the entry.
- Entry fees will not be refunded for any competitor/team who is required to attend the Novice Competitor Orientation, fails to attend, and then wants to start the rally.
- Refunds will be sent out after the rally is over.
- Entries that are withdrawn before February 1, 2026 will be refunded in full.
- Entries that are withdrawn between February 1, 2026 and the opening of registration will be refunded minus a \$100 administrative fee.
- There are no refunds after the opening of registration.

## 4 Insurance

### 4.1 Description of Liability Insurance Coverage

The Entry Fee includes the insurance premium to insure the competitor and other parties as necessary against all third party bodily injury and property damage for the amount of \$5,000,000 per occurrence.

### 4.2 Description of Accident Medical Coverage

All competitors, service crews and all event participants (staff, marshals, volunteers, etc.) have secondary medical coverage of \$1,000,000. There is a \$1,000 deductible for those without their own primary medical coverage.

### 4.3 Period of Insurance Coverage

In general all insurance coverage will come into effect at the opening of the Rally Office. For each participant it begins when they sign the insurance waiver. Insurance coverage will end at the close of the Rally Office or at the moment of competitor retirement, exclusion or disqualification.

## 5 Advertising

Any advertising must comply with United States federal law and South Carolina state law. If an advertising sticker package is supplied by the organizers of the Sandblast Rally it must be applied, or the entrant must pay a \$100 Advertiser's Compensation Fee. All advertising and decoration displayed at the event is subject to approval of the Sanctioning body. NRS officials may request that you cover or remove advertising, failure to comply will be considered withdrawing from the event.

## 6 Identification numbers

The regulations for car markings are found in the championship rules for the Atlantic Rally Cup. Vinyl is not mailed before events, it is picked up registration.

Numbers are assigned per the Atlantic Rally Cup Regulations. Specific numbers cannot be requested, ARC vinyl is free. Replacement vinyl that is required may be purchased at event registration.

Stickers, vinyl, paint, or graphics containing text or logos of alternate sanctioning bodies must be removed or covered with something completely opaque before arrival at scrutineering.

Service vehicle identification stickers shall be placed on the outside of the service vehicle windshield on the passenger side lower corner.

Any other vinyl provided by the event must be applied per guidance provided with the vinyl.

## 7 Tires & Fuel

This event places no additional restrictions on tires beyond the NASA Rally Sport GRRs. High Octane race fuel will not be available in Cheraw, South Carolina.

## 8 Testing & Reconnaissance

No testing or reconnaissance is allowed, with definitions and penalties as per the GRRs.

## 9 Administrative Checks and Registration

### 9.1 Location

SpringHill Suites by Marriott Cheraw 201 Front St, Cheraw, SC 29520

### 9.2 Verified at Registration

The following items will be verified at registration:

- Online entry (driver info, navigator info, vehicle info) with all required information completed.
- Driver, rider and navigator NASA membership status, unless verified online beforehand.
- Driver, rider and navigator rally competition license status, unless verified online beforehand.
- Driver, rider and navigator state-issued driving license card, unless verified online beforehand.

RallyMoto™ competitors will not need to present any paperwork on navigators.

### 9.3 Service Vehicle Registration

All service vehicles must be registered either with a state agency, or, in the case of imported cars, the federal government. Service vehicles must also be registered with the rally and insured for public road travel. Documentation proving this must be available at all times. Service vehicles must display the appropriate windshield sticker for access to the service park.

We recommend to teams renting service vehicles that they contact the rental company in advance to obtain insurance documentation. Alternatively, copies of your personal policy showing liability coverage when driving other vehicles will also be accepted.

Competitors with oversize service vehicles or trailers need to contact the registrar so we can reserve space for you in the service park.

### 9.4 Vehicle Registration & Licensing

All rally vehicles must be registered either with a state agency, or, in the case of imported cars, the federal government. All rally vehicles must be insured for public road travel. Documentation must be available for verification at any time during the event.

### 9.5 Competitor Packet Contents

Competitors will receive a competitor packet at registration upon completion of all administrative checks and signature of required waivers. ARC Competitor packets will include:

- Route Book (1, cars)
- Stage Notes (1, cars)
- Roll Chart (1, bikes)
- Route Book Preamble (1, bikes)
- Competitor vehicle vinyl (1)
- Service Vehicle Windshield Sticker (1)

## 10 Scrutineering, Sealing, and Marking

Scrutineers will check the safety and eligibility of the competition vehicles. Vehicles may also be checked for general road worthiness, homologation papers, verification of Vehicle Identification Numbers, or other aspects of vehicle legality. The driver, navigator or rider does not have to be present at Scrutineering; however, their helmets, driving suits and all other safety gear must be examined at the same time the vehicle is examined.

## 10.2 Log Books

Log books will be retained by the Chief Scrutineer. They may be picked up at the Awards Party. The Chief Scrutineer will be made aware of any DNFs and those vehicles will be inspected before the log books are returned. Following the event, it is the competitor's responsibility to retrieve their log book from the Chief Scrutineer.

NOTE: Competitors needing a new logbook will need to make an appointment with the chief scrutineer at least two weeks before the event to get a new log book issued.

## 11 Shakedown

There will be no Shakedown at Sandblast Rally 2026. Competitors are encouraged to enter Sandblast After Dark if they want more stage miles on Friday evening.

## 12 Start of the rally

### 12.1 Publication Times of Start Order

Sandblast Rally:

The provisional start order will be posted on the virtual noticeboard on Friday, February 27, 2026. The official start order will be posted Saturday morning on the virtual notice board.

Sandblast After Dark:

The provisional start order will be posted on the virtual noticeboard on Friday, February 27, 2026. The official start order will be posted later in the day on the virtual notice board.

The list of entrants will be updated periodically on the web site, [SandblastRally.com](http://SandblastRally.com).

The actual start order will be determined by the Steward of the Event and the Clerk of the Course. These officials will use speed-factors, an individual's competitive history, and the vehicles entered as input when deciding start position. Any appeals for changes to the start order must be submitted in writing to the Competitor Relationship Officer prior to the start of Sandblast After Dark on Friday evening.

### 12.2 Official Time

Official time will be synchronized to GPS time via available cellular networks.

### 12.3 Official Start Times

The first vehicle is scheduled to start Sandblast After Dark at 6:31pm on Friday evening.

The first vehicle is scheduled to start Sandblast Rally at TC0 at 8:31am.

The motorcycles will start the rally first, followed by the cars.

### 12.4 Start Area and Parc Exposé

All competing vehicles and crews for Sandblast After Dark must report to the Parc Exposé by the 5:30 PM.

All competing vehicles and crews for Sandblast Rally must report to the service park by 8:00am.

## 13 Running of the Rally

### 13.1 Time Card Changes During the Rally

Early check-in in accordance with GRR 2.22.4.1 is authorized for the final time control for Sandblast Rally.

### 13.2 Re-Starting

There are very limited opportunities for returning a vehicle to the field. The only point at which any reentry will be considered is at a service. The vehicle must be re-inspected by the Chief Scrutineer and approved by the Stewards and the Clerk of the Course. The vehicle will be scored as Did Not Finish (DNF). The vehicle will no longer be a competitor. Competitors will be re-inserted relatively close to their previous position.

### 13.3 Stage Note Disclaimer

The stage note system uses an automated computer program to generate a description of the special stage road using sensors fitted to a vehicle driven through each stage. The Stage Notes are intended for use without reconnaissance. They describe the route in more detail than the Road Book. The use of the Stage Notes is a direct contract between the competitor and P-Sport, Inc., with the organizer's involvement being limited to authorizing the use and facilitating the preparation and distribution on behalf of P-Sport, Inc.

## 14 Service Area

### 14.2 Access Times for Service Vehicles

Registered service vehicles may enter and leave the service areas from 6:00am - 8:00pm on Saturday. Vehicles not registered for service may not enter the service area. Windshield sticker must be affixed to registered service vehicles in order to enter the service park.

### 14.3 Service Area Size

Standard service areas are 20 feet by 40 feet per race vehicle. Competitors with oversize service vehicles or trailers need to contact the service park manager so we can reserve space for you in the service park using the procedure in 14.4

### 14.4 Service Park Assignments

Service assignments will be made by the Service Park Manager and posted in the Advance Information folder on Sportity. To aid the Service Park Manager in making assignments, a link to the Service Special Requests form will be provided in the "pre-event forms" folder on Sportity. All special requests to Service Park Manager are due via the form by the close of entries, earlier requests will be prioritized.

## 15 Prizes

Trophies for Sandblast Rally will be awarded within each class for first through third place. Overall winner will be awarded a trophy. No cash or other monetary prizes will be awarded by the organizers.

Trophies for the Sandblast After Dark will be determined based on the amount of entries.

Trophies for the combined stage times from Sandblast Rally and Sandblast after dark will also be awarded based on amount of entries.

## 16 Results

Results will be available via the NASA Rallysport Website with a link posted in Sportity. Provisional results will be posted for review via Sportity. Final results will be posted 30 minutes later or when all inquiries and protests have been resolved by the Stewards and the Clerk of the Course.

## **17 Novice Competitor Orientation**

The Novice Competitor Orientation (NCO) will be held via Zoom. Competitors who are not required to attend but wish to sit in on the seminar are welcome to do so.

Competitors who have not completed the required number of NCO courses must attend the NCO or you will not be allowed to start the event.
